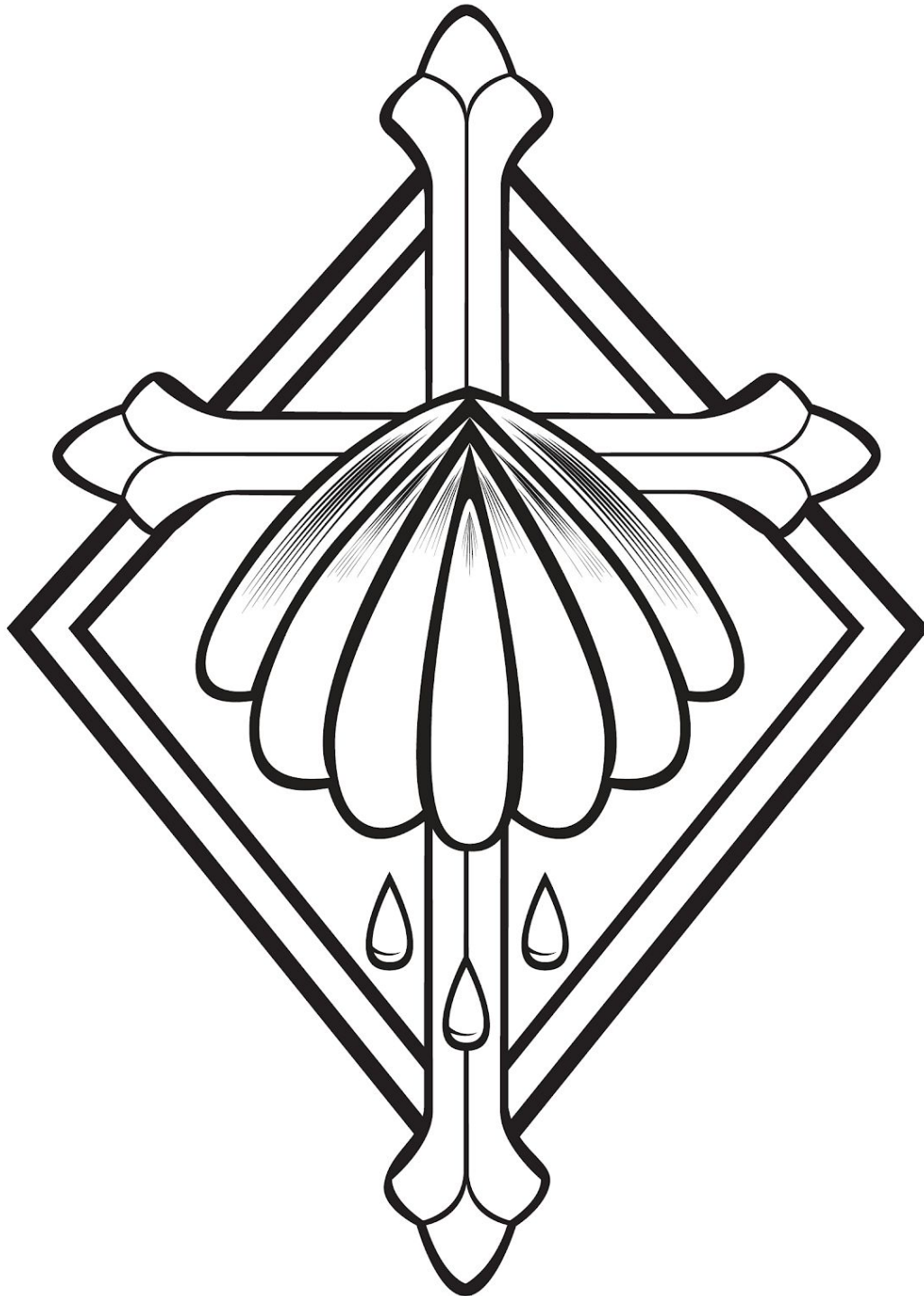

THE RITE OF HOLY BAPTISM



VERSICLES & EXHORTATION

P: Let us bless the Father and the ☩ Son and the Holy Spirit.

C: In Him we live and move and have our being.

P: We are buried with Christ by Baptism into death.

C: Just as He was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

P: As many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

C: According to His mercy He saved us, by the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit.

P: As many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus have been baptized into His death.

C: Baptism also now saves us through the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Beloved in the Lord! In the Word of God we learn that from the fall of Adam we are all conceived and born in sin and condemned to everlasting death. But we also learn that the Father of all mercy and grace has sent His Son Jesus Christ into the world to save sinners. In order that all men, women, and children might come to the knowledge of the truth as it is in Christ Jesus, He has entrusted Holy Baptism to His Church as a means of grace for our salvation. Our Lord has testified, “Unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God” and “He who believes and is baptized will be saved.” Therefore according to His command and promise we receive Robert Paul Webber into the Christian Church through the washing of regeneration, and we beseech our Savior graciously to receive him and to shower forth the power of the Holy Spirit, that he will be given the new birth of faith, the forgiveness of sins, and life everlasting.

PREFACE & CHRIST’S COMMAND

P: The Lord be with you.

C: And with your spirit.

P: Lift up your hearts.

C: We lift them up unto the Lord.

P: Let us give thanks unto the Lord our God.

C: It is good and right so to do.

P: It is truly good, right, and salutary that we should at all times and in all places give thanks to the almighty and everlasting God, through Jesus Christ, our Lord, who came to His disciples and said: “All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” The peace of the Lord be with you always!

P: Robert, do you renounce the devil, and all his works, and all his ways?

P: Do you believe in God the Son, the Redeemer of the world?

I do so believe.

P: Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit, the Lord and Giver of life?

I do so believe.

P: Do you wish to be baptized?

Yes.

Robert Paul Webber, I baptize you in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

APOSTLES' CREED

P: Let us confess the faith into which this child has been Baptized.

C: I believe in God the Father Almighty,

Maker of heaven and earth.

And in Jesus Christ,

His only Son, our Lord;

Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,

born of the Virgin Mary,

Suffered under Pontius Pilate,

was crucified,

Place in his hands the Holy Scriptures, and ensure that he is brought to the services of God's house, that he is provided future instruction in the Christian faith, to the end that he may come to the Sacrament of Christ's Body and Blood, and thus, abiding in baptismal grace and in communion with the Church, he may lead a godly life to the praise and honor of Jesus Christ. Is it your honest and sincere intent to do this?

Yes, with the help of God.

God enable you to do this faithful and loving work. By His grace may He fulfill what we are unable to do.
